

The uploading of files in the data pool under “Test objects” has also been optimized. When creating and editing a test object, you can now upload and save several files one after the other via drag & drop or with one click under “Attachments” on the right. The files can be opened enlarged in a new tab with a click or deleted with the red “x” icon.

Improved behavior of additional columns (planner and tester attributs)



To make it easier to distinguish the overview of attributes used in the additional columns, a new label with six states has been introduced in the left-hand column:

	not assigned	assigned and without value	assigned and with value
tester attribut	no change	no change	boarder with accent color
planner attribut	no change	green check icon	green check icon and boarder with accent color

Below the evaluation and feedback validation, there is a button with a “cogwheel” icon that leads to a “Select columns” dialog. Additional attributes can be configured here and added, deleted or edited as required. These attributes are then displayed in the additional columns.
